**LETTER OF AGREEMENT
Video and Audio Evidence Technician**

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter, "City") and the Minneapolis Professional Employees Association (hereinafter, "Union") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

Whereas, a study of a new position was conducted resulting in the establishment of a new professional classification titled Video and Audio Evidence Technician, with 358 points and allocated to grade 7 of the Staff Assistance Promotional Line. The classification is FLSA non-exempt.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. Video and Audio Evidence Technician, grade 7 and 358 total points, will be recognized by the parties as a classification for which the Union is the sole and exclusive collective bargaining representative; and
 1. The following salary schedule for Video and Audio Evidence Technician will be effective April 19, 2015, and is eligible for the June 2015 ATB for the unit.


