LETTER OF AGREEMENT
Environmental Health Community Liaison

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter, "City") and the Minneapolis Professional Employees Association (hereinafter, "Union") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

Whereas, a study of a new position was conducted resulting in the establishment of a new professional classification titled Environmental Health Community Liaison, with 373 points and allocated to grade 8 of the Staff Assistance Promotional Line. The classification is FLSA-Exempt.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. Environmental Health Community Liaison, grade 8 and 373 total points, will be recognized by the parties as a classification for which the Union is the sole and exclusive collective bargaining representative; and
1. The following salary schedule for Environmental Health Community Liaison will be effective April 29, 2015 (Note: the rates below are 2014-effective rates and the rates will increase by any 2015-effective increase provided to the MPEA group)


3. This letter represents the full and complete agreement in regards to this matter.
