

Important Notice About REPORTING SUSPECTED CRACK HOUSES

In the past, our message to the public had been; if you observe a great deal of short-time traffic at a dwelling, document and report this to your precinct Crack Team. Due to many reports coming in and that a lot of these reports were unfounded, we need to tighten the criteria by which a suspected crack house is reported to the precinct Crack Team.



In order for a suspected address to be investigated it will be necessary that there be something more than high traffic. This might include **observing:**

- people coming and going from a side window
- an actual transaction (the passing of small objects between 2 people)
- fortification of the residence

High traffic can still be used to raise your suspicions, but that alone will not generate a response from the precinct Crack Team.
