

**SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET**  
**RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION**  
**Minneapolis Police Department**

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **2600 Block Of Golden Valley Road, The Willard-Hay Neighborhood.**

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

The Minneapolis Police Department is available to help you by providing you with useful information on personal safety. The Minneapolis Police SAFE Unit may be contacted at **612-673-2833** to assist you in forming block clubs and receiving information on crime prevention. They will also provide tips to instruct your children on personal safety.

**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: White Male, 6'3", 188 Lbs, Slender Build, Blue Eyes, Bald (Shaved head), Fair Complexion And Clean Shaven.**

**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: This offenders victim pool are minor aged males aged 5 to 11. The offender was acquainted with all victims because he had been a school bus driver/family friend to victim's and their families. Mr. Hanson betrayed their trust by using his position of authority and engaging in Grooming Behavior with the children. Families allowed "Overnights" at Mr. Hanson's home.**

**CONDITIONS OF RELEASE: SUPERVISION**

**No direct/indirect contact with minors. Defined As: Initiating contact.**

**May not live in a building where children are present.**

**Must not be/live within one block of schools/parks/playgrounds ,or parking ramps  
Successfully complete sex offender programming.**

**May not possess/view sexually explicit materials in any venue ,or establishment.**

**May not own/operate a vehicle without agent approval.**

**May not own/operate a computer with internet capability, or call sex/chat/dating.**

**,or social lines. May not possess/create modification of images by paper/digital.**

**Maintain full-time work/education.treatment for a 40 hour week combined.**


**Must comply with Polygraphs and Electronic Monitoring (GPS) as directed.**

**No use of media to solicit personal contact.**
