

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET
RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION
Minneapolis Police Department

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **5700 Block Of Sander Drive, The Wenonah And Morris Park Neighborhoods.**

THIS OFFENDER IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME.

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

The Minneapolis Police Department is available to help you by providing you with useful information on personal safety. The Minneapolis Police SAFE Unit may be contacted at **612- 673-2839** to assist you in forming block clubs and receiving information on crime prevention. They will also provide tips to instruct your children on personal safety.

THE RELEASED OFFENDER: Clarence Joseph Opheim Dob 08/15/1947

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: White Male, 5'10", 214 Lbs, Large Build, Brown Eyes, Very Short Grey Hair (Balding) And Fair Complexion. Glasses

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Mr. Opheim's victim pool are both male and female, aged 8 to 17. To acquire his victim's Mr. Opheim employed a combination of stealth, bribery, manipulation and in one case a weapon, to gain compliance. Mr. Opheim often initiated conversation with his victim's which led to secluded contact at other locations, including his home. Mr. Opheim was acquainted with his victim's. Note: There is no record of stranger to stranger sexual contact.

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE: SUPERVISION DHS

The Department Of Health And Human Services Will Supervise

Mr. Opheim's supervisor will oversee his day to day activities, have regular face-to-face contact, manage and monitor his movements to include GPS tracking. Transportation will be supplied as needed according to a schedule. This effort combines the forces of several inter-active support partners.
