

**SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET**  
**RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION**  
**Minneapolis Police Department**

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **2500 Block Of Golden Valley Road, The Willard-Hay Neighborhood.**

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: African American Male, 6'00", 185 Lbs, Medium Build, Brown Eyes, Black Hair (Head Shaved), Dark Brown Complexion And Clean Shaven.**

**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Mr. Hamilton car jacked an adult females car that he was not acquainted with. This offender attempted to sexually assault the victim ,but was unsuccessful. The offender then stole the victim's car, cash and other valuables. Force and threats were used to gain compliance.**

**CONDITIONS OF RELEASE: SUPERVISED RELEASE**

Comply with sex offender, chemical dependency and other programming.

No direct/indirect contact with minors. **Defined as:** Initiating contact..

May not purchase/possess/create sexually explicit materials or enter sexually oriented establishments. May not belong to any clubs, groups, or gangs.

May not possess/create modified images whether on paper/video, or digital.,

Maintain a full time schedule of work/treatment/volunteer activities.

Submit to polygraphs and comply with GPS monitoring as directed by his agent.

May not own/operate a motor vehicle without agent approval.

May not own/operate any networking device w/internet capability or access social networking. \* Cannot call sex/chat/dating/social lines.

May not enter establishments that serve alcohol as a primary business.
