

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET
RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION
Minneapolis Police Department

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **1800 Block Of Pierce Street N.E. The Windom Park Neighborhood.**

THIS OFFENDER IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME.

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

The Minneapolis Police Department is available to help you by providing you with useful information on personal safety. The Minneapolis Police SAFE Unit may be contacted at 612- **673-2874** to assist you in forming block clubs and receiving information on crime prevention. They will also provide tips to instruct your children on personal safety.

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: African American Male, 6'00" 230 Lbs, Medium Build, Brown Eyes, Black Hair (Head Shaved), Medium Brown Complexion, With A Short Beard And Mustache. **Vintage Photo:** 10/24/2012

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: This offender's victim pool are females aged 12 to adult. In victimizing the adult female, this offender burglarized her home and then used physical force to subdue her prior to the sexual contact. The offender was not known to this victim. In a 2nd case, this offender made sexual contact with a 12 year old female he was acquainted with through mutual friends.

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE: SUPERVISION

No direct/indirect contact with minors. **Definition:** May not initiate contact. May not enter establishments that sell alcoholic beverages as a primary business. Successfully complete sex offender and chemical dependency programming. Comply with anger management/ domestic assault programming. May not own/operate a device with internet capabilities or utilize sex/chat/dating ,or social inter-action communications. May not possess/create modification of images whether paper/video/ or digital. Maintain full time work/education/treatment ,or in combination. Must submit to polygraphs and Electronic Monitoring (GPS) as directed. Mat not possess/purchase sexually explicit materials in any venue. May not own/operate a motor vehicle without agent approval.
