**Re:** Neighborhood Submissions for CPP funding at January 25, 2011 NCEC meeting

I am pleased to report that we have received and reviewed 34 submissions from neighborhood organizations for review and approval by the Neighborhood and Community Engagement Commission at the January 25, 2011 meeting. I would like to thank these organizations for providing thoughtful and detailed submissions given the short timeline.

1. After staff review of the submissions, we recommend the following 31 submissions for approval by the Commission:

Most of the organizations have submitted bylaws. For those organizations that have not yet submitted bylaws, we will not proceed with a contract until we have had an opportunity to review their bylaws.

2. Staff recommends provisional approval for two submissions:

East Phillips Improvement Coalition	\$58,430.39
Northside Residents Redevelopment Council	\$20,000.00

For East Phillips, staff have requested clarifications on and revisions to some budget items in the submission. Once we have received sufficient clarification, we would like to proceed with a contract.

For Northside Residents Redevelopment Council, staff have requested clarifications to budget items, and would like to see a more complete submission from the organization. In the meantime, staff recommends an allocation of \$20,000.00 to provide funding for NRRC over the next few months while we explore options for the budget issues, and can provide them assistance with developing a more complete submission.

3. Staff recommends deferring approval of the submission from the West Bank Community Coalition. NCR staff will work with stakeholders in the neighborhood to the extent possible to identify underlying issues, bring in additional resources, and resolve ongoing conflicts prior to making a recommendation. The West Bank Community Coalition has requested \$53,153.00.
