<sup>\* -</sup> The Holland, Windom Park, Nicollet Island, Northeast Park, Audubon Park, Bottineau, Waite Park and St. Anthony East Community Oriented Public Safety Initiative (Safety 1.E.1.) was funded through the NRP Community Oriented Public Safety Initiatives Reserve Fund (COPSIRF) for a total of \$58,575; Windom Park's portion of the allocation is \$7,321.87. Final expenditures for this initiative are \$49,925.84; Windom Park's share of these expenditures is \$6,240.73. Since the allocation is from the Community Oriented Public Safety Initiatives Reserve Fund, the allocation is not included in the total Action Plan Request calculated above, nor does it count against the neighborhood's Phase II allocation.

<sup>\*\* -</sup> On December 13, 2010, the City Council adopted a policy that requires each neighborhood to limit its Phase II Neighborhood Action Plan obligations to no more than 50% of their full neighborhood allocation. The Policy Board, on July 25, 2011, based on City Council action of April 1, 2011, released additional funds to bring the limit up to 66.02% of the full neighborhood allocation.
