

consolidate remaining funds from several Phase I and Phase II strategies to more current and relevant strategies in the neighborhood's Phase II NRP Plan.

Recommendation

I have reviewed the proposed Action Plan modification, and have found that:

- The request is the result of lessons learned during implementation of the Central Neighborhood Action Plan and responds to the continuing and re-evaluated priorities of the neighborhood;
- The modification reallocates more than \$100,000 of NRP funds between strategies;
- The modification does not change the amount of NRP dollars committed to the neighborhood for its Neighborhood Action Plan;
- The Central Neighborhood has followed the process required by the NRP Policy on "Changing Approved Neighborhood Action Plans and Early Access Requests";
- The modification is an appropriate and reasonable use of the funds;

Given these findings, we recommend the following resolution to the NRP Policy Board for action at its January 2016 meeting:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the NRP Policy Board hereby accepts and adopts Plan Modification #30 to the Central Neighborhood Phase I Neighborhood Action Plan and Modification #1 to the Phase II Central Neighborhood Action Plan.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That the Minneapolis Neighborhood Revitalization Program Policy Board hereby recommends that the City Council [a] approve the Plan Modification and [b] direct appropriate City staff work with neighborhood the organization and other jurisdictions to implement the Plan Modification as necessary.
