

You are invited to a public meeting regarding the West 36th Street Protected Bike Lane and Pedestrian Path Project



Minneapolis Public Works is hosting a meeting to present a final project concept before moving into final project design and construction in summer 2014.

Project Background

There is currently no sidewalk on the south side of W 36th St between E Calhoun Pkwy and Dupont Ave S. This corridor is also lacking a bicycle facility. Due to the low number of cross streets, the south curb line of W 36th St provides a unique opportunity to create a comfortable trail-like facility for bicyclists and pedestrians and improve eastbound bus stops.

The project would require the removal of one eastbound travel lane on W 36th St. Parking removal is also proposed for the south side of W 36th St between Bryant and Dupont.
