Re: 15th Ave. /4th St. Reconstruction Project Update

Dear Stakeholders:

The 15th Ave. /4th St. Reconstruction Project is now in the second stage of work. Traffic detour signage is up and 4th St S (Cedar Ave to just west of 16th Ave S) and 16th Ave S (south of 6th St S) is open. The second stage construction area, around the intersection of 15th Av S and 4th St S, is closed.

BUSINESSES OPEN: For access to the Brian Coyle Center, Currie Park and 15th Ave S, please use the 6th St S detour. **NO PARKING** signs will be up and enforced along the construction zone on 4th St S and 16th Ave S (south of 6th St S). Please be aware of the no parking and detour signs during the construction.

*** For the second stage, the curb and gutter has been completed and asphalt paving is planned for next week. Immediately following the placement of the asphalt surface, the third stage of work will commence. The third stage of work will involve the closing of the area around the intersection of 6th St S and 15th Ave S. Private utility work from Centurylink, Centerpoint Energy, and Xcel Energy will be ongoing through the construction zone.***

The final lift of asphalt for the project will be completed as one pour later in the project schedule to provide a continuous durable surface. Please expect some areas will not be finalized even though we are working in other sections of the project limits. This is to provide access or due to coordination of other construction activities.
