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Dear Stakeholders:

The sidewalk construction project is wrapping up for this season. Signing and parking meters are currently being installed. The remaining work with the lighting system is planned for this winter. Tree planting by Minneapolis Park Board is planned for next spring. The final striping and seal coating is planned for next summer.

The City has also funded the placement of a *rectangular rapid flash beacon* with an audible pedestrian system as part of the improved pedestrian crossing. This is a late addition to the project and the system will be installed next year. The remaining sidewalk is awaiting the reconstruction of the signal system at 4th St S/Cedar Ave/Riverside Ave and will be constructed as part of that project. The signal work at the intersection of Riverside Ave and Cedar Ave will be continuing for the next few weeks. For short durations during the work the signal system will need to be taken out of service to facilitate the signal system updates. We will work to keep the service disruptions to a minimum.

Thank you for your patience during construction. We hope you are enjoying the refreshed look of the corridor.
