


# Recommendations for bicycling improvements to NE/SE streets connecting to the Stone Arch Bridge

- Name the corridor the "Presidents' Bicycle Boulevard north of E Hennepin Avenue, and the "Stone Arch Bridge Bicycle Boulevard" south of E Hennepin Avenue
- Move north-south stop signs to east-west direction on Tyler Street at 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, to reduce stops for bicyclists
- Install curb extensions on Tyler Street NE at 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NE and remove north-south stop signs, to reduce stops for bicyclists, slow down motorists, and reduce crashes
- Install speed bumps on Polk Street NE at 23<sup>rd</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> Avenues NE and remove north-south stop signs, to reduce stops for bicyclists, slow down motorists, and reduce crashes
- Construct a traffic circle on Fillmore Street NE at Spring Street NE and remove 4-way stop, to reduce stops for bicyclists, slow down motorists, and reduce crashes
- Install overhead pedestrian/bicycle flasher on E Hennepin Ave at 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, to make crossings safer
- Construct curb extensions on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE at 7<sup>th</sup> Street, to slow motorists
- Construct curb extensions and bicycle push buttons on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE at University Avenue & 4<sup>th</sup> Street, to make it easier for bicyclists to register at the stoplight
- Other improvements intended to raise the visibility of bicyclists include:



The public review process began for this project in November 2009, and will end in April 2010. Minneapolis Public Works is now sharing staff recommendations for improvements for bicycling along these streets. These recommendations arose out of the input of people who currently bicycle along the corridor, while also considering the needs of people who live, run businesses, drive, and walk on this street.
