

Notice of Public Meeting about a future bicycle boulevard on 17th Ave S

The City of Minneapolis invites you to a public meeting about a proposed bicycle boulevard on 17th Avenue S.

This meeting will discuss possible changes on:
12th Avenue S, between Minnehaha Parkway and 54th Street
17th Avenue S, between 38th Street and Minnehaha Pkwy

When: **Tuesday, October 12th, 6:30 pm**

Where: **Bethel Evangelical Lutheran Church, 4120 17th Ave S**

This project is intended to provide a north-south route for people bicycling in the Northrup neighborhood. **It will NOT include parking removal.** On a bike boulevard, cars and bicycles share the driving lane. A bike boulevard includes traffic calming and improves bike and pedestrian crossings at busy streets. It also includes pavement markings and bicycle way finding signs.

Minneapolis Public Works has developed a draft layout with several possibilities. The public will be asked to rank preferences. **All possibilities will NOT be constructed.**

Possibilities in Northrup (between 42nd St & Minnehaha Pkwy) include:

- **42nd Street & 17th Avenue:** Median on 42nd Street
- **43rd Street & 17th Avenue:** Miniature traffic circle*, reverse stop signs from north-south to east-west
- **45th Street & 17th Avenue:** Miniature traffic circle*, reverse stop signs from north-south to east-west
- **46th Street & 17th Avenue:** Curb extensions on 46th Street
- **Minnehaha Pkwy & 17th Avenue:** Curb cut access to bicycling and walking trails
