

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Minneapolis Public Works Department will hold a public meeting on Thursday, June 18th at 6:30 pm at St Frances Cabrini Church (1500 Franklin Avenue SE) to discuss proposed striping and signing changes to install bicycle lanes on 27th Avenue SE, between 4th Street SE and East River Parkway.

In order to accommodate bicycle lanes, Public Works is recommending:

- **The removal of on-street parking** on the *west side* of 27th Avenue SE for 1 block between Yale Avenue SE and East River Parkway (12 spaces).
- **The addition of on-street parking** on the *east side* of 27th Avenue SE between Yale Avenue SE and I-94 (7 spaces).

This will result in a net loss of 5 parking spaces.

A bicycle ride will take place immediately before the public meeting. Proposed changes will be introduced and participants will ride along the proposed bike lanes. Please bring a bicycle in good working condition (motor vehicles are encouraged to ride along as well). Meet at the 5 Corners intersection of 27th/Franklin/East River Parkway at 5:45 pm, next to the stairway at the southwest corner.
