The draft copy of the Annual Report was also posted on the City's website, and a Public Hearing notice was posted in the March 31, 2006 edition of Finance and Commerce. On April 18th, 2006, a public hearing was held at the Transportation and Public Works (T&PW) committee meeting, for the purpose of receiving input regarding the City of Minneapolis' Stormwater Management Program and Annual Report; no comments were received at this year's Public Hearing. Additionally, concerned parties were invited to submit written comments by mail or e-mail until April 18th, 2006; no written comments were received.
