

Notice of Public Meeting about potential lane changes

You are invited to a public meeting to discuss potential lane changes on Fremont Avenue N.

When: **Thursday, May 27th – 6:30 p.m.**
Where: **North Regional Library, 1315 Lowry Ave, Minneapolis**

Minneapolis Public Works is exploring replacing one of the two Fremont travel lanes with a bike lane, between Plymouth and Lowry Avenues. There would be no impact to parking.

A bike lane is also being proposed on Emerson Avenue, where no lane changes would occur.



Public Works staff is collecting information about the potential impact of this change in order to make a recommendation.

These bike lanes would connect to bike lanes on the 2-way portion of Fremont Avenue further north, between 33rd Avenue and Webber Pkwy.
