

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Minneapolis Public Works Department will hold a public meeting on Monday, June 29th at 6:30 pm at Harrison Park Recreation Center (503 Irving Avenue N) to discuss proposed striping and signing changes to install bicycle lanes on Glenwood Avenue, between Xerxes and Royalston Avenues.

In order to accommodate bicycle lanes, Public Works is recommending:

- The **removal of on-street parking** on the *north side* of Glenwood Avenue between Xerxes Avenue and Penn Avenue.
- The **removal of on-street parking** on *both sides* of Glenwood Avenue between Cedar Lake Road and Aldrich Avenue.
- The **addition of on-street parking** on the *south side* of Glenwood Avenue between I-94 and 12th Street N.

An option that will also be presented is the **removal of on-street parking** on the *south side* of Glenwood Avenue between Penn and Gramercy Avenues.

A bicycle ride will take place immediately before the public meeting. Proposed changes will be introduced and participants will ride along the proposed bike lanes. Please bring a bicycle in good working condition (motor vehicles are encouraged to ride along as well). Meet at the intersection of Glenwood/Royalston/12th Street N at 5:30 pm, next to the Cedar Lake Trailhead at the northeast corner.
