

Penn Avenue S. Phase I Reconstruction Update May 31, 2013

Meyer has completed all removals between 60th and just south of 54th Streets

Meyer is continuing with the construction of storm sewers between 58th and 54th Streets

All hydrant work between 60th and 54th has been completed

CenterPoint Energy has installed the new gas main between 59th and 53th Streets. The line is now in service. 55 and 54 services

All cross streets are open with the exception of the the east side of 59th

UPCOMING EVENTS

Starting the week of June 3:

Meyer Contracting will continue storm sewer work north of 58th .

Michel's will be connecting services on 5400 and 5500 blocks.

On Tuesday June 4, the City of Minneapolis will be paving from just north of the 60th St intersection to approximately 100 feet north of the 58th St intersection. This work will require a closure of Penn Avenue and the intersections of 58th and 59th while the paving is completed.

On Wednesday June 5, the City of Minneapolis will begin concrete work from just north of the 60th St intersection to approximately 100 feet north of the 58th St intersection

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

Sprinkler Systems, Boulevard Gardens and Pavers in Public Right of Way

Residents should remove any irrigation systems and salvage special plantings on City of Minneapolis right of way.

Asphalt Paving

Residents on Penn living between 60th and 58th Street should park in alleys or on cross streets for the week of June 4th. Persons in need of special accommodation should contact Chris Trembath Engineering Technician at 612-919-1196.

Concrete Cure Time

Following the asphalt placement; new concrete curb and gutter, driveway aprons, bus pads, and sidewalk will be placed. Once these concrete structures are poured they will be blocked off to allow the fresh pavement to cure. If the approach to your driveway is on Penn Ave., we will notify you in advance of placing your new driveway approach and ask you to park at another location for eight days.

Trash and Recycling

No changes will be made to the pick-up locations of garbage and recycling collected by the **City of Minneapolis**. Businesses that have private vendors collect their trash should advise their vendor of the upcoming construction.

Traffic

Extra speed enforcement has been requested for the areas around the project.
