The Minneapolis City Council is considering a street redesign project on 3rd Avenue S between 1st Street S and 16th Street S. The project limits are shown on the attached map.

The scope of the project includes the installation of a protected bicycle lane, modifications to the existing street configuration, and new landscaping opportunities along 3rd Avenue S. The construction is proposed to begin in May of 2016. There will be no direct assessments with this project.

The Department of Public Works will hold an informational meeting to address any questions that you may have about the 3rd Avenue S Redesign project. The meeting will be held on **Monday, January 4, 2015 at 1:00 p.m., with repeat presentations at 2:00 p.m., and 3:00 p.m.** If you wish to attend, you would only need to attend one of the three presentations.
