Dear Minneapolis Taxpayer,

The Minneapolis City Council is considering a street reconstruction project in your neighborhood to improve the condition of the street. The proposed project encompasses 26th Avenue North between West Broadway Avenue and Lyndale Avenue North and between 2nd Street North and the Mississippi River, as shown on the attached map.

The Department of Public Works will hold an informational meeting in your neighborhood to address any questions that you may have about the street reconstruction along 26th Avenue North. The meeting will be held at **6:30 p.m., Monday, January 25th**, at:

The street reconstruction will include the full removal of the existing street, new pavement, curb and gutter, ADA compliant sidewalks, driveway approaches, bike path, utility work, and landscaping. Construction is anticipated for the 2016 and 2017 construction seasons.

Enclosed you will find an official Notice of Public Hearing regarding the street improvements and related assessments for your specific property.


