**RE: North Loop Street Reconstruction and North Loop Pedestrian Improvements**

Dear Property Owner/Tax Payer/Resident,

The City of Minneapolis Public Works is planning to reconstruct segments of five streets in the North Loop during the 2019 construction season. This project will include full reconstruction of the existing street including subgrade work, pavement, curb and gutter, driveways, sidewalk, streetscape elements, and utility work (as needed). Street segments that are scheduled for reconstruction are:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> St N (5<sup>th</sup> Ave N – 10th Ave N)
- 5<sup>th</sup> Ave N (Northeast of 5<sup>th</sup> St N – Washington Ave N)
- 7<sup>th</sup> Ave N (4<sup>th</sup> St N – Washington Ave N)
- 8<sup>th</sup> Ave N (3<sup>rd</sup> St N – Washington Ave N)
- 9<sup>th</sup> Ave N (3<sup>rd</sup> St N – Washington Ave N)

A second, related project in the North Loop is also scheduled for construction in 2019. This project will make pedestrian crossing improvements at approximately a dozen or more intersections. More information on these two projects can be found on the City project webpages:
