

Community Garden Compost

Fall Compost Details



Thank you for your interest in the City of Minneapolis' Community Garden Compost Program, managed by the Division of Solid Waste and Recycling.

Availability

Fall compost is available October 1 through November 1 each year.

*Requests for Fall compost must be received **by the third Friday in September.***

Community Garden Requirements for Participation

- Community Garden must be located within the City of Minneapolis

Community Garden Requirements for Delivery

- All low-cost compost and/or low-cost compost delivery fees must be paid before the delivery.
- A community garden representative must be there to accept delivery.
- The delivery area must be clearly marked with stakes, flags, and/or other type of marker.
- The delivery area must be accessible by a large truck, and be free of low-hanging wires or other obstructions.

Cost

No-Cost Option

- Amount: 200 cubic yards of no-cost compost is available for Fall delivery.
- Delivery: 15 no-cost deliveries are available for Fall compost.

Once no-cost compost and deliveries run out, community gardens will be contacted regarding low-cost options, or referred to local retailers for their compost needs.

Low-cost Option

- Amount: 1,000 cubic yards of low-cost compost is available for Fall delivery, at a rate of \$11.00 per cubic yard.
- Delivery: 75 low-cost deliveries are available, at rate of \$120 per delivery.
- Authorization to bill charges through a Minneapolis Utility Billing account is required.

Once low-cost compost runs out, community gardens will be referred to local retailers for their compost needs.

Delivery Schedule

- Deliveries are available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.
