

Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee Minutes
Wednesday, May 23, 2018, 4 PM – 6 PM

Members Present: Attendance was not taken for this meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 4:03 pm and was chaired by Nick Mason.

Actions

1. The Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee supports the general layout of the **10th Ave Bridge** project as presented with the addition of an approximately 3 ft. tall barrier or means to ensure snow clearance of pedestrian and bicycle facilities.
2. The Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee supports the general layout of **Hennepin Ave. from Washington to 12th Street** as presented with the proposed process of a working group made up of BAC, PAC and MACOPD members for more detailed design and recommends maximizing the behind curb space and eliminating driveway access where possible.
3. The Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee supports the eastbound aspect of the **Lowry Ave N gap** project but not the westbound behind curb aspect of the project with the following additional recommendations: 1. delineators on eastbound bike lanes 2. bike lane pavement markings through intersections 3. reduction of travel lane widths west of 3rd Street and addition of buffers to existing bike lanes in same section.
4. The Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee supports the listed projects for the **2018 Regional Solicitation** as presented.
