

Qualifications & Experience Requirements

Public Works Service Worker I Trainee

- 18 Years of age by October 31, 2019.
- High school Diploma or GED Equivalent.
- Possess and maintain a valid Class D Driver's License, with the ability to obtain a Class B CDL with Tanker endorsement within 6 months of employment.

Public Works Service Worker I

- 18 Years of age by October 31, 2019.
- High school Diploma or GED Equivalent.
- Possess and maintain a valid Class B CDL with No Air Brake Restrictions
- One (1) year experience performing manual labor in a similar environment including operation of construction equipment.

Public Works Service Worker II

- 18 Years of age by October 31, 2019.
- High school Diploma or GED Equivalent.
- Possess and maintain a valid Class B CDL with No Air Brake Restrictions
- One (1) year of experience (within the last five (5) years) and the ability to operate 2 of 5 preselected pieces of equipment.

Water Works Service Worker I

- 18 Years of age by October 31, 2019.
- High school Diploma or GED Equivalent.
- Possess and maintain a Valid Class D Driver's License
- One (1) year of experience working with water main pipes or related equipment, or similar equipment.

Water Works Service Worker I Trainee

- 18 Years of age by October 31, 2019.
- High school Diploma or GED Equivalent.
- Possess and maintain a Valid Class D Driver's License
