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VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

In signing the application, I understand and agree to the above policies and following statements:

1. I will never strike an animal, or handle an animal in such a way that it would be construed as rough or abusive. I will always exercise compassion and care with the animals.
2. I authorize Minneapolis Animal Care & Control to seek emergency medical treatment for me in case of accident, injury, or illness.
3. I agree to abide by the MACC policies and procedures presented to me during volunteer training and as updated thereafter.
4. I have read and agree and will abide by the volunteer policies and procedures listed in this application.
5. I have read, agree and will abide by MACC's Safety Policy.
6. I will take ideas, constructive comments, suggestions, and criticisms directly to the Volunteer Coordinator or another supervisor.
7. If communication problems develop between employees or other volunteers and me, as soon as possible, I will report these to the Volunteer Coordinator.
8. I will NOT speak to any member of the "media." I will direct all "media" requests to the Volunteer Coordinator. The term "media" include all T.V., radio or print reporters, producers, photojournalists or print media, and/or anyone else associated with these mediums.
9. I agree not to provide information to (or about) former owners of animals, adopters of animals, animals housed at the shelter, employees or volunteers to anyone unless my supervisor has approved divulging such information.
10. Photo authorization: I expressly grant MACC, and to its employees, agents, and assigns, the right to reproduce an image of me and/or my pet in connection with the exhibition and publication of media including, but not limited to, live presentations, database records, slide shows, and print materials.
11. I agree to make a volunteer commitment of at least six (6) months. I also agree to work a minimum of four (4) hours per month to stay active in the program,
12. I understand that my volunteer assignment may be terminated at any time at the discretion of the Volunteer Coordinator or my supervisor.
13. Volunteers who fail to comply with safety rules and animal care protocols will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
14. I will not possess, use, sell or be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while on City of Minneapolis property, premises or while volunteering at MACC functions.
15. As a condition of being accepted as a volunteer with the City of Minneapolis Animal Care & Control, I agree to maintain a high degree

of ethical standards and be law abiding in all respects. I further acknowledge and agree to a background check to determine by driving record and any criminal proceedings against me (when applicable). Should any unethical or illegal behavior be discovered, this may jeopardize my eligibility to volunteer.

- 16. I am offering my time and services to the City of Minneapolis Animal Care & Control purely as a volunteer and without any expectations of payment of any kind. I understand that I will not be compensated for such services in any way. I hereby waive any claim for wages for the time and services volunteered by me.
- 17. I am at least 16 (sixteen) years of age.
- 18. If I am between 12 and 15 years of age, I must sign up to volunteer as part of a youth/adult (parent/guardian) team.

I verify that all of the above information is true, complete, and correct, and I understand that if it is not, I am disqualifying myself for a volunteer position. I also understand that I am applying for a volunteer position and that this is not an application for, or contract for, employment. I authorize the above references to give MACC any pertinent information they may have and authorize investigations of all statements contained herein.
