



## University of Minnesota Game Day

### Residential Parking

- Vehicles must be parked on approved surface (asphalt, concrete, brick pavers, etc.) in the rear 40 feet of the lot.
- A maximum of two vehicles per dwelling unit are allowed.
- Recreational vehicles longer than 25 feet are prohibited.

### Commercial Parking

- A Class A Commercial Parking Lot license or Class C Temporary Parking Lot license is required.
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited.
- Commercial parking lot requirements:
  - Must be paved
  - Conspicuously marked spaces
  - Landscaping
  - Fencing
  - Bumper curbs
  - Signs showing:
    - Parking rates
    - Contact information
  - Must keep all surface areas, driveways, sidewalks and boulevards free and clear of all accumulation of dirt, weeds, rubbish, garbage and litter.
  - Must ensure that the area 300 feet in any direction from the perimeter is cleared of all rubbish, garbage, or other dangerous or unwholesome substances within four (4) hours of the termination of a special event.

### Alcohol

- A license is required to sell alcohol.
- Temporary on-sale licenses may be granted.
- Current license holders may apply for temporary expansion of license.

### Business Requirements

- Remove litter daily within 100 feet of the establishment.
- Store solid waste and recyclables in approved containers.
- Enclose refuse storage containers on all four sides.
- Maintain buildings, fixtures and grounds.
- Remove graffiti must be promptly.

## **Amplified Sound**

- No outside sound amplifying equipment, including stereos, microphones, etc. is allowed without a permit.

## **Tailgating**

- No alcohol allowed.
- Must provide an adequate number of porta-potties, garbage containers, and hot coal containers.
- Wood fires are prohibited.

## **Peddlers, Solicitors, and Transient Merchants**

- City issued identification badges are required for peddlers, solicitors and transient merchants. MCO 332.70
- Individuals representing religious or political organizations must register with the city. License and identification badges are not required. MCO 332.70
- Youth fundraisers must wear an identification badge. MCO 332.70
- Individuals may not remain on another's property if requested to leave or a placard is posted. MCO 332.80 and 332.90
- Sales are prohibited on public sidewalks. MCO 427.130

## **Short-Term Food Permits**

- Food stands require a short-term food permit.

## **Temporary Parking Lot License**

Businesses may apply for a temporary event parking lot license near the TCF Stadium at the University of Minnesota to provide parking for up to 15 events per year. Owners must comply with the requirements listed under Commercial Parking pertaining to signs, paving, litter removal, prohibition of alcohol, and more.

## **What Happens If You Are in Violation?**

1. Expect a letter, telephone call, or visit from a License Inspector describing the complaint or violation.
2. Take this notice seriously. Call your Inspector for information or solutions.
3. Failure to comply with violation orders may result in citations, fines, suspensions, and revocation of your license to operate.
