
# Food Safety

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
- **Nationally 48 million food-borne illnesses a year**

# Total Number of Facilities vs. Staff






## State of the Unit since 2002

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- 811 (24%) more Facilities


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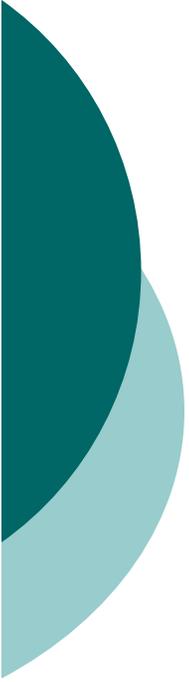

**Total Number of Critical Violations**

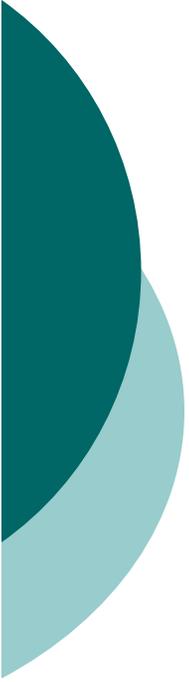


## State Delegation

***“The Board may be subject to Termination”***




## State of the Unit Today

- Lack of time to educate and provide customer service


# Number of Facilities Per Inspector



\*The City of Bloomington conducts two routine inspections per year in high and most medium risk food establishments. Therefore, the average number of routine inspections per inspector in the City of Bloomington is 226.

\*\*Based upon FDA *Voluntary National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards – Standard 8* recommendation of 8-10 hours of inspector staff time should be allocated per facility per year.

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
