Background/Analysis:

This claim arises out of multiple work related injuries suffered by Claim of Joshua Young while he was a officer with the Minneapolis Police Department from March 27, 2006 to November 6, 2015.

Any workers' compensation settlement in excess of \$75,000 must be approved by the Council. We have reached a tentative settlement of Mr. Young's workers' compensation claim and PERA disability award appeal on a full, final, and complete basis in the amount of \$180,000 from Fund/Org. 06900-1500100-145400. This proposed settlement has been discussed with the Police Department and it is in agreement with the terms. We believe that the settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend approval by this Committee.
