Contract amendment with SecuroNet, LLC. to expand the scope of services

Description:

Authorizing an increase to Contract No. C-39098 with SecuroNet, LLC. by \$114,000, for a new not-to-exceed total amount of \$154,298, and extending the contract for three years through Dec. 31, 2019, to add a new scope of service enabling the Minneapolis Police Department access to private and public entities to join forces on a virtual safety network to prevent, reduce, and investigate crimes.

Background/Analysis:

The City established a Contract with SecuroNet, using the vendor's form that enables private and public entities to join forces on a virtual safety network to prevent, reduce, and investigate crimes. SecuroNet members can easily collaborate, share video data and utilize an arsenal of capabilities on a secure platform. SecuroNet will design, develop and implement video camera mapping to provide location tracking of law enforcement and streaming of live video.

The following items are provided by this application:

SecuroNet SafeLink: Enables the City of Minneapolis to easily know where cameras are located and quickly access information to address problems and solve crimes.

SecuroNet VideoLink: Allows City of Minneapolis businesses to securely share real-time exterior camera feeds.
