The City of Minneapolis will reconstruct about half a mile of 1st Ave N between Washington Ave and 8th St N. This project aims to improve the right-of-way for all people in all the ways they move around.

- Intersects many bus routes and is next to a light rail stop
- Located in the Warehouse Historic District
