Appointments

The HPC received one new first-term commissioner in January, Paul Bengtson, and confirmed the reappointments of three existing commissioners: Chris Hartnett, Ginny Lackovic, and Ian Stade.

Paul Bengtson was appointed to fill the vacancy created by the term limit of Chad Larson. Paul is a student completing a Master's of Science in Architecture: Heritage Conservation and Preservation at the University of Minnesota. With his Master's degree and over a decade of experience as a planner and having staffed boards and commissions in the past Paul is a huge asset to the HPC.

34rd Annual Statewide Historic Preservation Conference

The American Association for State and Local History held its 2014 National Conference in conjunction with the 34th Annual Statewide Historic Preservation Conference in Saint Paul, MN, September 17 through 20.

The following staff attended the conference: Andrew Liska and John Smoley. In addition to attending, Dr. Smoley presented a session titled "Bring Historic Preservation to our Community!"

Current Commissioner Chris Hartnett, HPC's 2014 Secretary, and Commissioner Ian Stade also attended the conference.

National Alliance of Preservation Commissioners (NAPC)

The Commission Assistance and Mentoring Program (CAMP) is NAPC's signature training program. Launched in the early 1990s, the program provides intensive, on-site training for local preservation commission members. Chris Hartnett, current commissioner and Minneapolis HPC's 2014 secretary, attended CAMP in Faribault, MN on August 22.

Minneapolis Heritage Preservation Awards

Co-sponsored between the HPC, the Minneapolis Chapter of the American Institute of Architects, and Preserve Minneapolis, the Preservation Awards recognize individuals and projects that promote and enhance heritage preservation in Minneapolis. The 23rd Annual Preservation Awards ceremony and luncheon was held on May 15, 2014, at the International Market Square.

Historic Restoration, Rehabilitation, or Adaptive Reuse Project

These are projects that return an existing place, property, building, or landscape to its original character in a manner that is respectful to the property's historic past, or which transform and reinvent the property to incorporate both new and old elements in a way that is respectful of yet different from the form of the past. The following projects received this honor:

New Addition to an Historic Building

Designation: September 19, 2014

The residence is a Tudor Revival style single family house of wood frame construction with exterior walls of half timbering framing panels of stucco and limestone details. It is eligible under Criterion #1 for its association with fair employment practices in Minneapolis, Criterion #2 for its association with Mr. Amos Samuel Deinard – attorney and civil rights supporter, Criterion #4 as it is an excellent example of the 1920s Tudor Revival Style, Criterion #5 for its integrated and intact landscape design, and Criterion #6 for its association with master architects Jacob Liebenberg and Seeman Kaplan.

CLG Grant

The City of Minneapolis was very pleased to have its FY 2014 \$14,978 certified local government grant application fully funded. The grant funds four designation studies of properties significant for their association with streetcar-related development.

This year's proposal initiates a long-awaited phase of designation study work following decades of preparation. The Minneapolis Preservation Plan initiated in the late 1980s and developed in the 1990s, identified topics worthy of context statements. These, in turn, guided reconnaissance-level survey efforts in the 2000s, which earmarked properties in a variety of topics worthy of further investigation. The 2013 Capstone survey further refined these recommendations. CPED is now investigating these properties, topic-by-topic.

As of the date of publication of this report, three properties have been successfully nominated and have designation studies in progress: The Thomas Lowry Memorial at 2330 Hennepin Avenue South; the Camden Park State Bank at 705 42nd Avenue North; and the Northside Station at 2418 Washington Avenue North. The Lowry Hill East Potential Residential Historic District is also being considered. Contact John Smoley at 612.673.2830 with questions.

National Register of Historic Places Nominations

The HPC commented favorably on the following NRHP nominations:

Hollywood Theater

2815 Johnson Street Northeast

Eligible under Criterion A and under Criterion C for being a Liebenberg and Kaplan-designed Streamline Moderne neighborhood movie theater emblematic of the commercial patterns and trends of movie theater ownership and development in the years between World War One and World War Two, which saw theaters proliferate outside the central business district and within commercial nodes along streetcar lines.

Lake Harriet Methodist Episcopal Church

4401 Upton Avenue South

Eligible under Criterion C for its remarkable integrity of original materials and rarity of style in a primarily residential setting, as an ecclesiastical structure, make it unique among the existing Classical Revival buildings in Minneapolis.

Arthur and Edith Lee House

4600 Columbus Avenue South

Eligible under Criterion A for its association with the 1931 protests which took place at 4600 Columbus Avenue South, as well as with broader trends of housing discrimination in Minneapolis.

Cameron Transfer and Storage Building

756 Fourth Street North

Eligible under Criterion C for epitomizing the rapid evolution of structural design for warehouses in the first decade of the twentieth century from traditional timber building techniques honed over centuries to one reliant upon innovative engineering and the use of new materials, specifically through its use of both timber post-and-beam and reinforced-concrete mushroom-slab structural systems in the building.

Plymouth Building

12 Sixth Street South

Eligible under Criterion C in the area of engineering as a representation of the development and acceptance of reinforced-concrete skeleton frame construction by the American building industry.

Permits and Design Review

The Minneapolis Heritage Preservation Ordinance requires the HPC and CPED staff to review alterations to Landmarks, properties within historic districts, and properties under interim protection. Additionally, the ordinance requires CPED staff to review all wrecking and moving permits prior to issuance by the City to determine whether the affected property is a historic resource. If CPED staff determines that the property is a historic resource, the demolition requires approval by the HPC.

Certificates of Appropriateness

The HPC reviewed 33 Certificate of Appropriateness applications.

Historic Variances

The HPC reviewed and approved 13 Historic Variance applications.

Appeal of the Planning Director

The HPC did not review appeals of the Planning Director.

Demolition of Historic Resources

The HPC reviewed seven applications for the Demolition of a Historic Resource and approved two.

Certificates of No Change

CPED staff administratively reviewed 177 Certificate of No Change applications for minor alterations that did not change the historic integrity or visual character of the property.

Wrecking Permits

CPED reviewed and approved a total of 183 wrecking permits.

Heritage Preservation Files and Inventory

Community Planning and Economic Development (CPED) is located in room #300 of the Public Service Center Building, 250 South 4th Street, and retains Landmark nominations and survey forms for properties in the city as well as inventory files for designated districts and other potentially historic properties. Some of these materials are in survey form and typically contain brief descriptions of the resource or building, an approximate date of construction, a statement of significance, and a photograph. For locally designated properties, CPED maintains records on applications that have gone before the HPC for approval, as well as minutes from HPC meetings. There is also a collection of books maintained on the history of Minneapolis.

Research and Contacts

Survey and research information is available to the public during normal business hours. Those interested in researching any potential or known historic resources are encouraged to call for an appointment with CPED staff to discuss their specific needs or to view the HPC collection.
