

2026 Vision Zero Safety Improvements

35th St E at 16th Ave S and 17th Ave S

Project overview

The City will install concrete pedestrian refuge medians on 35th St E at 16th Ave S and 17th Ave S to:

- Allow people walking and rolling to navigate one direction of traffic at a time;
- Create shorter crossing distances for people walking and rolling across the street;
- Improve vehicle yielding to those walking and rolling across the street;
- Promote safe driving;

What we know

- A small number of our streets (9%) are where the majority (66%) of severe or fatal crashes are happening.
- We know that the following people are overrepresented in severe and fatal crashes:
 - People walking;
 - People rolling;
 - Historically marginalized groups.

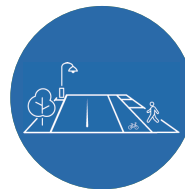
Project goals
