

34th St Neighborhood Greenway

Hennepin Ave to Hiawatha Ave

Project overview

- Almost four mile East-West route along 34th St from Hennepin Ave to Hiawatha Ave.
- Identified as a near-term, low-stress bikeway on the All Ages & Abilities network.
- Route connects two schools and four parks.
- Travels along or connects to a total of ten different existing or planned bike routes.

What is a neighborhood greenway?

- **Bicycle boulevard:** Maintains existing street but includes traffic calming and crossing improvements.
- **On-street trail:** Includes dedicated space to walk, roll, and bike and traffic calming. This may involve converting street from two-way to one-way.

Types of improvements may include:

- ADA pedestrian ramp upgrades
- Traffic calming
- Low-stress bikeway
- Bump-outs and medians
- Improved crossings
- New signage and pavement markings

Project goals

- Improve safety for walking, biking, and rolling for all ages and abilities
- Make it easier to cross at intersections
- Calm traffic and discourage unsafe driving
- Create a safe and comfortable bicycle route that connects to parks and schools
