RE: 42<sup>nd</sup> Ave S and 44<sup>th</sup> St E Pavement Rehabilitation Project

Dear Minneapolis Resident or Business Proprietor,

This letter contains important information about a traffic detour which will affect you. The 2022 concrete pavement rehabilitation will be starting soon in your neighborhood. This letter is to inform you of impacts to your residence and/or business during the construction.

Our construction activities are likely to cause you some inconvenience, but we are hopeful that you will be patient and understanding as the work progresses. For our part, we will do our best to keep these inconveniences at a minimum.

- Starting Monday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, 44<sup>th</sup> St East from 46<sup>th</sup> Ave South to Edmund Blvd. Affected residents will still be able to access their homes via the alley. See detour maps on the next page.
- Starting Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 44<sup>th</sup> St East will be closed from 42<sup>nd</sup> Ave South to 46<sup>th</sup> Ave South. 46<sup>th</sup> Ave South will remain open to through traffic. Affected residents will still be able to access their homes via the alley, and on-street parking is available on 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave S, 44<sup>th</sup> Ave S, and 45<sup>th</sup> Ave S. We anticipate each section will be reopened within 3 weeks of construction starting, weather permitting. The most common question I receive is about building the roadway in halves instead of having a full closure. The answer is that full closures are preferred two reasons: they expediate the construction and make it safer for our workers not having to work next to live traffic. One way access is provided for blocks that do not have alley access to residential driveways.

I would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding while your neighborhood is being improved. If you have questions, I'm holding weekly construction outreach meetings virtually on Tuesdays at 2:30 p.m. If you can't make the meetings, my contact information is below. 


