November/December




Enterprise Retention Schedule

The Records Management staff is working with a consultant to develop an updated Record Retention Schedule for the City enterprise.

This project is required by law and ordinance. It has been approved by the City, Minnesota Historical Society, State Auditor, and Attorney Generals office.

The Clerk's Office will develop procedures to help ABC Staff to manage, retain, and destroy records.
