To qualify for this program, a family needs to:

- > Have a child or children with asthma from ages 0-21
- Live in the City of Minneapolis, either as a renter or homeowner



Asthma is often triggered or made worse by common things found in homes such as: dust mites, mold, pets, cockroaches, and second-hand smoke.

We want to help reduce these possible asthma triggers. There is no cost to your family.

A walkthrough of your home by a specialist trained in asthma and housing problems including air testing in your home to look for problems
