Project Background

Safe Routes To School within Minneapolis is a collaborative, interagency effort between Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS), Public Works, Police Department, and Health Department among other partners.

The focus of this program is on enhancing bicycle and pedestrian facilities to connect schools, parks and other neighborhood destinations throughout the city. Safe Routes To School projects typically include bikeway improvements, traffic calming elements (such as traffic circles), and pedestrian crossing improvements (such as median refuge islands or bumpouts).





