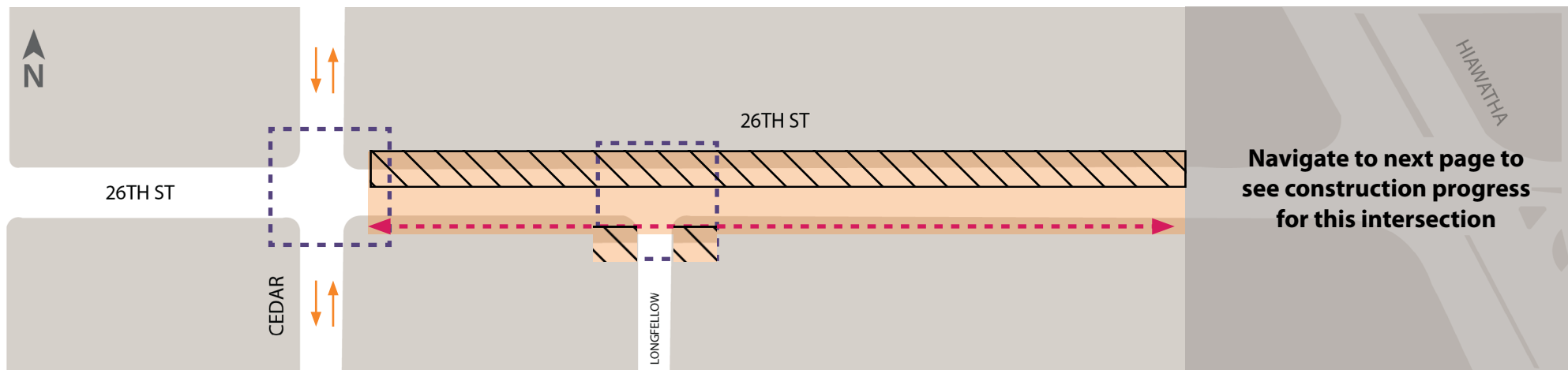

What's happening

26th St to Hiawatha Ave

- Boulevard topsoil placement on the N.side of E 26th Street b/t Cedar and Hiawatha
- Seeding and erosion control blanket placement for N.side boulevard.
- Sidewalk removals and grading at the SE and SW corners of Longfellow and E 26th Street



What to expect

26th St to Hiawatha Ave

- Roadway and utility work will start on the E.side of Hiawatha Ave on E 26th Street next week
- Concrete placement for sidewalks and pedestrian ramps early next week. Followed by median construction at Longfellow
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring

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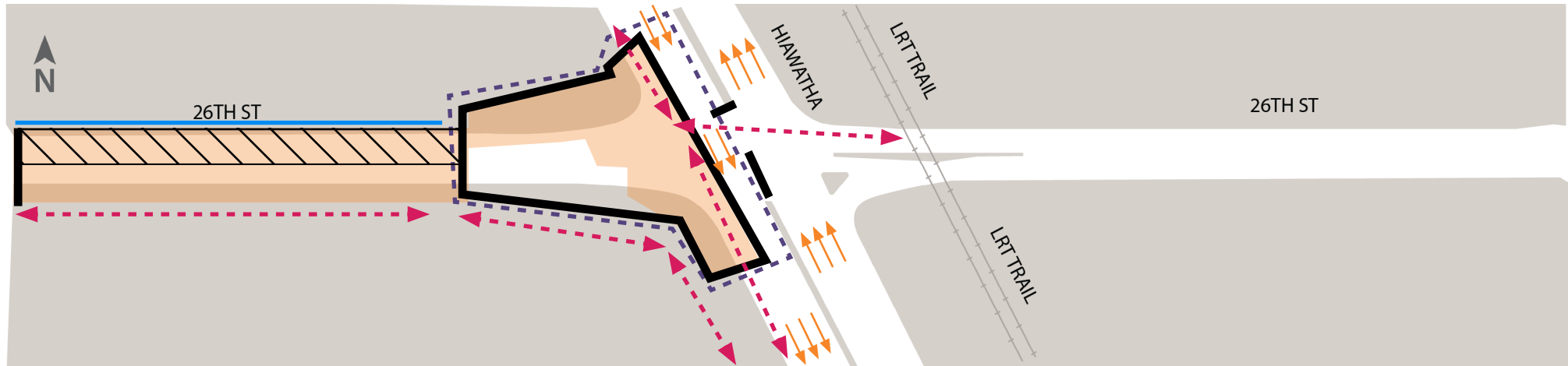

What's happening

E 26th Street & Hwy 55

- Boulevard topsoil placement on NW and SW corners of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- Concrete pavement will have joints hot sealed this Friday
- Seeding and erosion blankets for grass areas



What to expect

E 26th Street & Hwy 55

- Roadway and utility work will shift to the E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring
- E 26th St west of Hiawatha will reopen to traffic next week with striping happening at a later date
- Access to Jefferson Lines will be maintained during construction.



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
