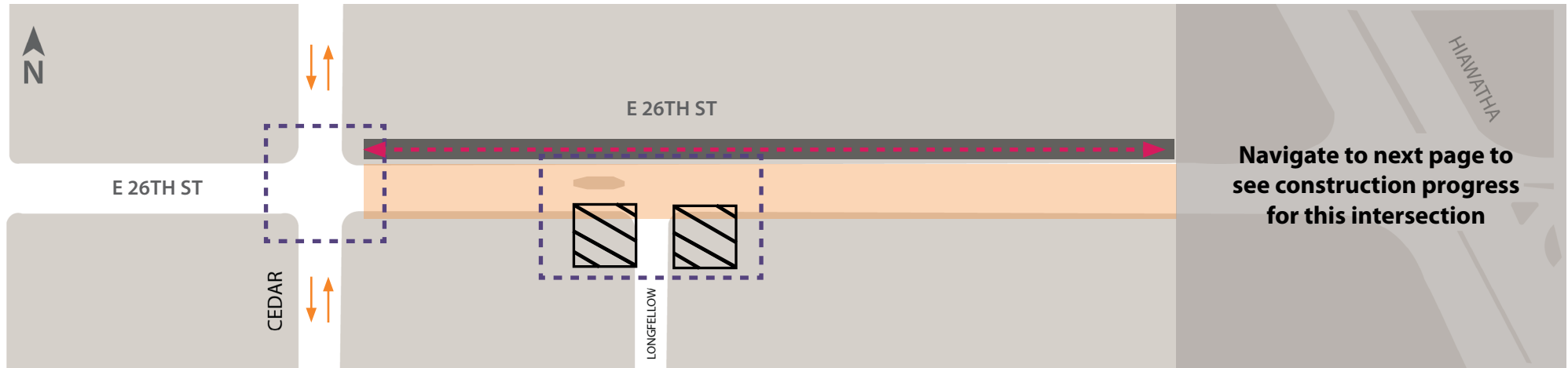

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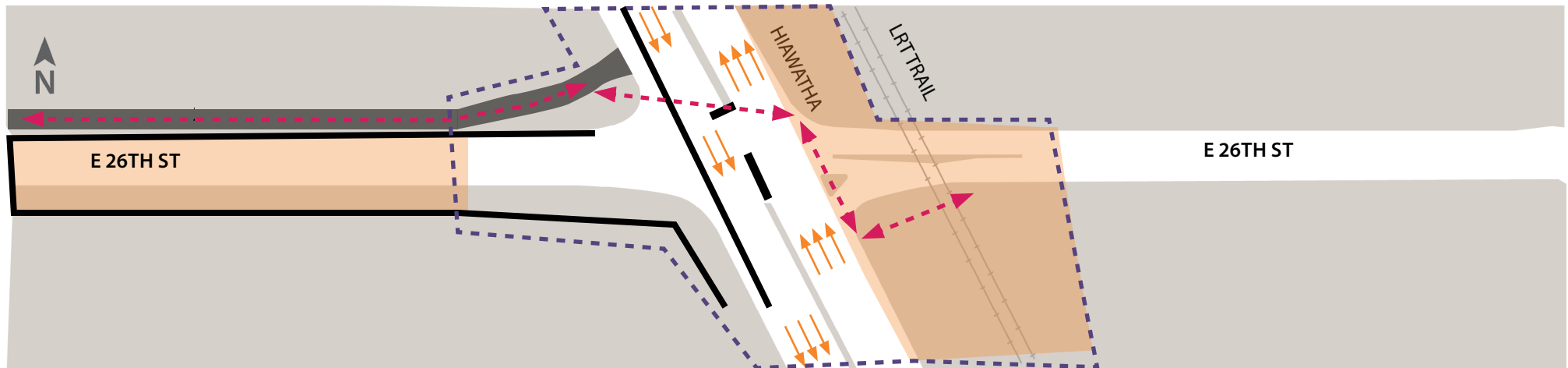

What's happening

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Concrete paving on E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- Grading for concrete trail, sidewalk and median.



What to expect

- Roadway and utility work will continue on the E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- Access to Jefferson Lines will be maintained during construction.
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring.

- Concrete trail and sidewalk placement on the E. Side of Hiawatha Ave and E. 26th Street
