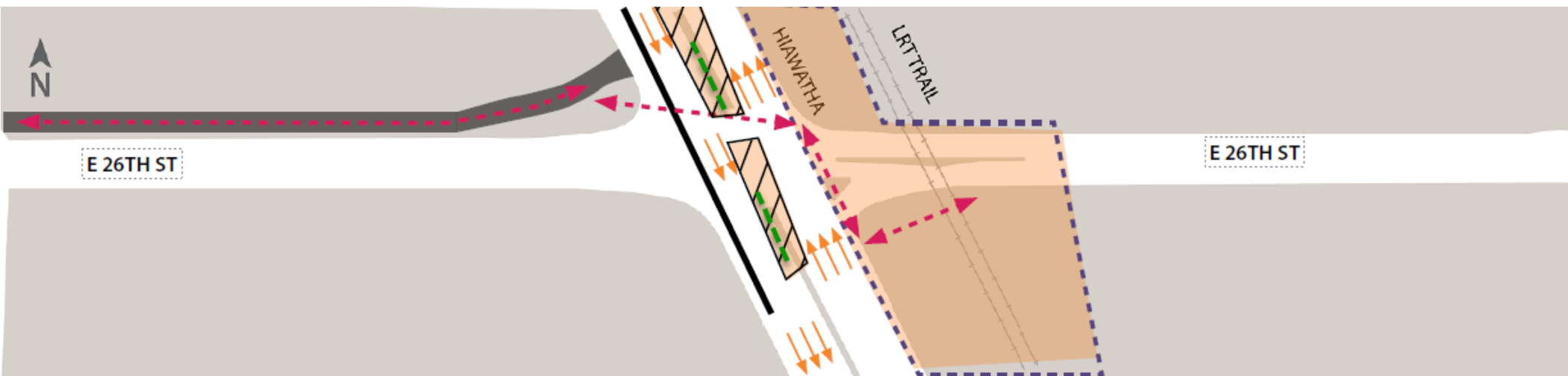

What's happening

E 26th St & Hwy 55

Metro Transit has completed their "State of Good Repair Project"

- E 26th Street between Cedar Ave and Hiawatha Ave is now open to traffic.
- Concrete work for North and South medians on Hiawatha started this week. Pedestrian ramps in the median areas will be completed next week.



What to expect

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Roadway and utility work will continue on the E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street.
- Access to Jefferson Lines will be maintained during construction.
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring.
- Topsoil and seeding for NE and SE corners of Hiawatha Ave and E 26th Street.
- E.side of Intersection of E 26th Street and Hiawatha will remain closed until permanent signal poles are received. Anticipated this fall.

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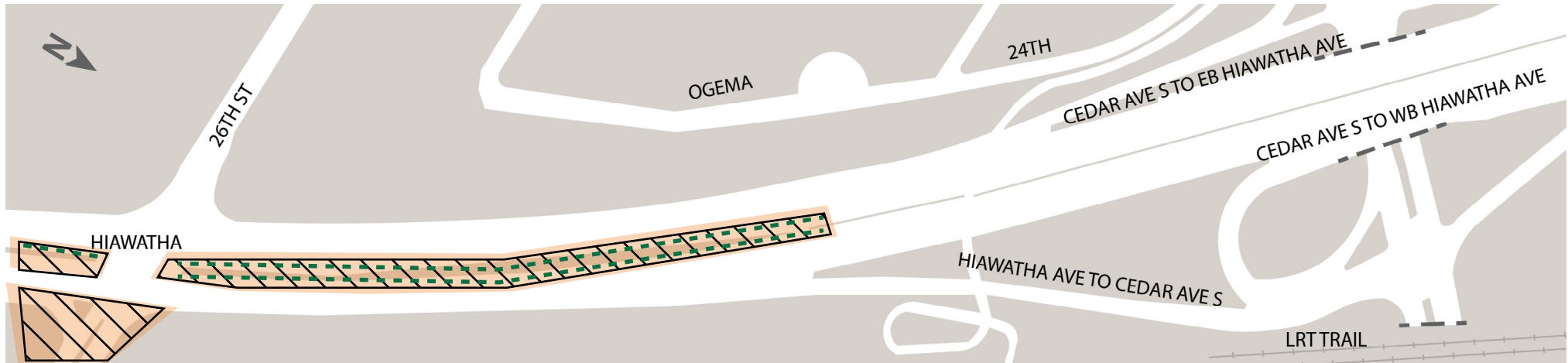

- Grading and Base for Median barrier placement the week of September 7th.
- Curb and Gutter placement for new medians at E 26th Street and Hiawatha.
- Concrete paving for the NB & SB lanes were completed on 8/25/26.
