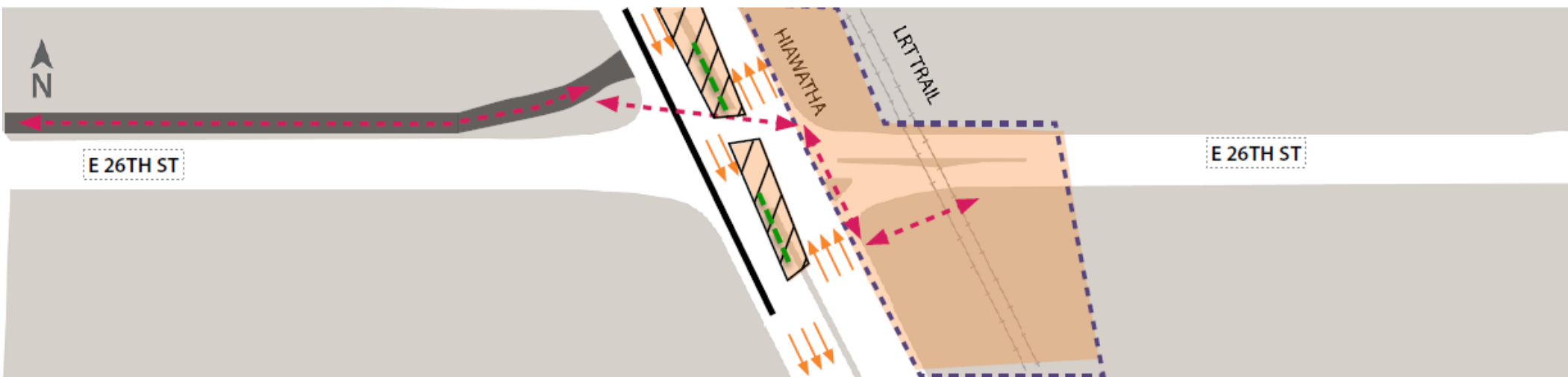

What's happening

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Median Barrier on Hiawatha Ave was placed this week.
- General site cleanup



What to expect

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Roadway and utility work will continue on the E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street.
- Access to Jefferson Lines will be maintained during construction.
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring.
- Pedestrian ramps in the median areas are expected to be completed next week
- Signing and striping on Hiawatha Ave is expected the week of September 21st.
- E.side of Intersection of E 26th Street and Hiawatha will remain closed until permanent signal poles are received. Anticipated this fall.

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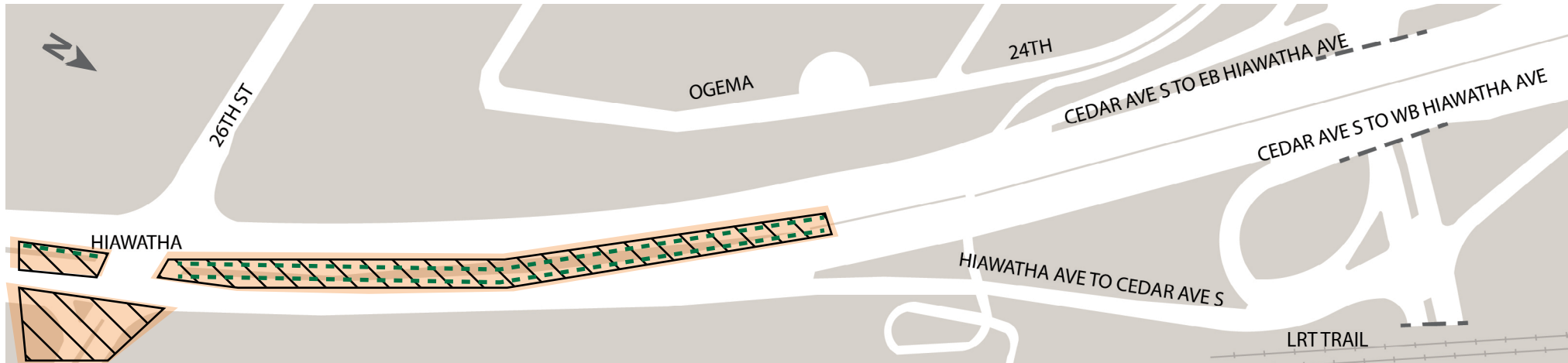
