

Re: Minnehaha Concrete Pavement Rehab

March 21, 2023

Dear Minneapolis Resident/Business Owner:

This letter is to provide you with notice that construction will begin the week of April 3rd on Minnehaha Ave between 24th St E and Franklin Ave (see attached map). This is a continuation of the sawing work that was done during the summer of 2022.

This project involves full and partial replacement of damaged concrete street panels. There are also planned reconfigurations of the intersections at (Minnehaha Ave and E Franklin Ave) and (Minnehaha Ave and 21st Ave S) that improve pedestrian access. These intersections will also include green infrastructure (plantings) that will collect a portion of the storm water.

Construction will be done in two phases to allow Minnehaha Ave to remain open to traffic. There will be road closures at 21st Ave S and 22nd St E when the crew is working there. Detours will be in place for the closures and no on-street parking will be enforced along Minnehaha Ave during construction. You will still have access to and from your property. This project is scheduled to be substantially completed by June.
