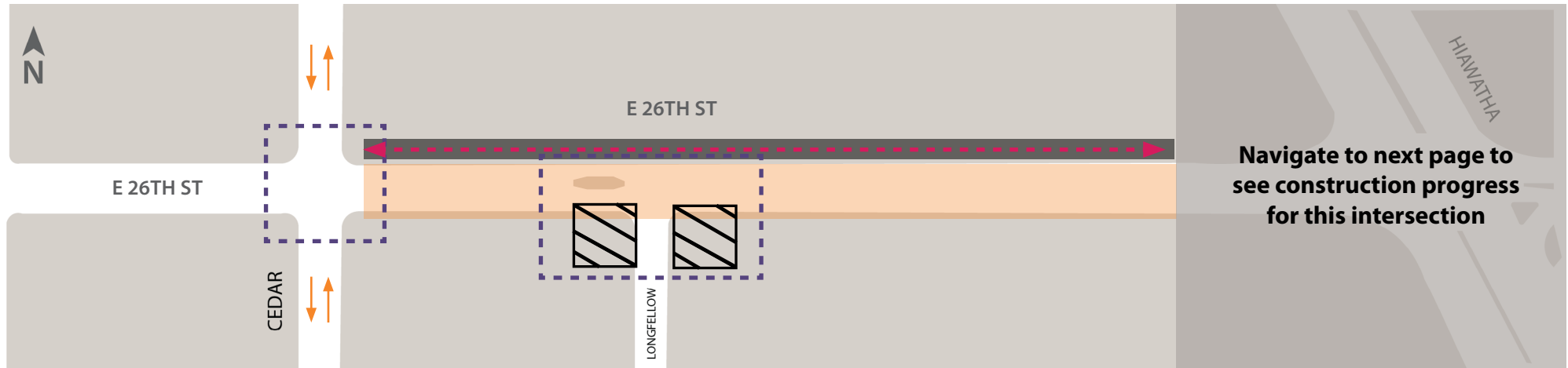

What's happening

E 26th St to Hiawatha Ave

- Curb and gutter and sidewalk pedestrian ramps at the SW and SE corners of Longfellow and E 26th Street
- General site cleanup and restoration



What to expect

E 26th St to Hiawatha Ave

- Traffic will be shifted to the north side of the road with barriers setup on the south side of E 26th Street.
- Q3 will be restoring Lead service line patches on the S.side of E 26th Street.
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring.

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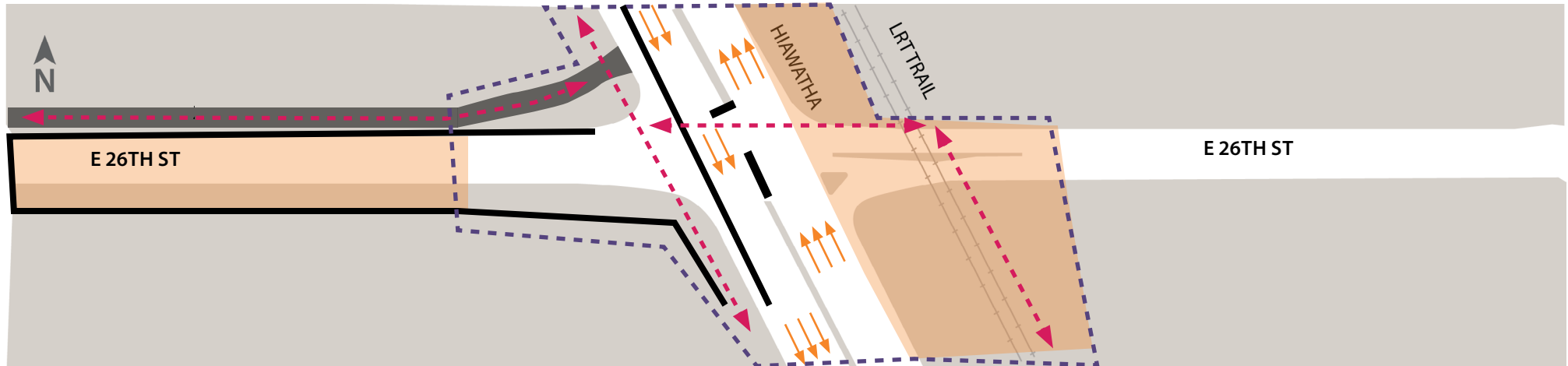

What's happening

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Boulevard topsoil placement on NW and SW corners of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- Seeding and erosion blankets for grass areas
- Sawcutting and removals on the E. Side of the Intersection of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- General site cleanup and restoration



What to expect

E 26th St & Hwy 55

- Roadway and utility work will continue on the E. side of Hiawatha and E 26th Street
- E 26th St west of Hiawatha will have some site restoration done by Q3 Contracting to restore patches from CenterPoint Energy early next week.
- Access to Jefferson Lines will be maintained during construction.
- Pedestrian detours will be set up as needed. Greater impacts can be expected at intersections where work is occurring.
- E 26th Street will remain closed at Hiawatha until final striping and site restoration is completed.



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
