Minneapolis residents at risk of eviction can get help paying rent and utilities



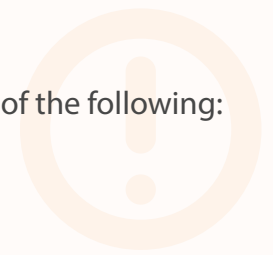
YOU CAN RECEIVE ASSISTANCE IF:

- ✓ You live in **Minneapolis**.
- ✓ Your household income is at or below **30% of the area median income (AMI)**.
- ✓ You received a **30-day eviction notice** from your landlord.
