



Exclusive 4d Participant Funds

4d Green, Healthy and Affordable Housing Energy Efficiency Cost Share Application

Overview:

Building owners who have gained 4d tax status through the City of Minneapolis for their properties are eligible to apply for exclusive funds and resources, including their energy efficiency projects. The City of Minneapolis is committed to creating opportunities for building owners and tenants to reduce their energy costs, as well as environmental and carbon footprint.

All 4d Qualified Multifamily Residential Buildings: 90% match up to \$50,000.

City cost share incentive and Utility rebate combined will equal 90%

City cost share incentive = Total Project Cost- Utility Rebate – 10% owner match

Application Deadlines: March 1, May 1, July 1, 2019

First come, First Served: Projects approved until funding is exhausted

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be enrolled in the 4d Program for a period of 10 years
- 2. Project can include lighting but must have a non-lighting component.
- 3. Project energy savings must be verified through a third party assessment and must be eligible for an Xcel Energy or CenterPoint Energy rebate.
- 4. Building owner must provide at least a 10% match for the project
- 5. Any open housing orders that are past due need to be abated before payment from the City can be made.
- 6. Funding is limited to existing buildings only. Project can include common areas, tenant units, building systems and shell, and/or exterior lighting.





Application Timeline:

November 2018 Application available/Application submissions accepted

November 2018 – June 2019 Use a third party energy efficiency assessment to identify potential projects.

March 1, 2019
 1st deadline for early approval

May 1, 2019

July 1, 2019

 3rd /Last Application Deadline
 All projects to be completed

• December 8, 2019 Final day to submit documents for reimbursement

	Building Owner will provide at least 10% of the funds for the project		
	Cost share funds can only be used to compensate for materials and labor specified on the cost share bid		
	Ineligible costs include labor costs of applicant's employees		
	All work must meet City of Minneapolis zoning, building, fire, and all other regional, state or national code requirements		
If you are awarded a cost share, the following must occur:			
	All improvements must be completed by November 20, 2019. Reimbursement request documents must be provided by December 8, 2019. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that product purchases, equipment purchase and installation, or other work proposed have been completed satisfactorily before paying the contractor(s).		
	Cost share funds will be disbursed to the applicant by the City Cost Share Fund Manager. The cost share applicant must submit the following items to the program manager upon completion of the work. If more than one contractor is used, there must be complete sets of the items listed below for each contract/contractor/vendor: Third party assessment report		
	Before and after photographs from the same vantage point highlighting the improvement		
	Proof of final inspection by the City of Minneapolis for any work requiring a City permit.		
	Final paid invoice from the contractor or vendor showing the total project cost		
	Rebate eligibility verification		
	Any open housing orders that are past due need to be abated before payment from the city can be		
	made.
