

Overview of using Microsoft Teams


- How to ask a question

Project Overview

- E 34th Street from Clinton Ave to 10th Ave S, and 10th Ave S from E 33rd ½ Street to E 28th Street.
- This <u>Federal</u> project will include:
- _ Bituminous and concrete surfacing
- _ ADA and crossing improvements
- _ Separated bike lane
- _ Traffic signal upgrades
- Water and sewer improvements

Project Scope

- Scope of work includes:
 - Modify the existing roadway to add an on –street two-way protected bikeway
 - ADA improvements
 - Intersection improvements at E 34th St & Portland Ave <u>and</u> E 34th St & Park Ave
 - Utility Improvements (storm and water)
 - Raised-crossing improvements
 - Traffic signal replacement
 - Expanded boulevard Stormwater management/GSI, and Trees

Estimated Total Project Cost: \$ 2.1 Million

Construction Overview Schedule

- Construction anticipate start date: Mid-July, 2024
 - Contractor: Thomas & Sons Construction, Inc.
 - Construction staging plan:
 - _ Stage 1: East 34th Street
 - Stage 2: 10th Ave South
- Substantially completion date: Late November, 2024

Traffic Control and Access

- Partial Closures on E 34th Street and 10th Ave S.
 - Local access for resident will be maintained.
- There will be times that will be difficult to access into and out of the area.
 - We will work with you on individual access into your property.
- Access to driveways will be closed for short periods during driveway apron concrete placement.
 - We will coordinate with property owners.
 - We will ask you to park another location for 7-8 days.

Coordinated Work

- Contractor (removals, earthwork, water, storm sewer, asphalt, concrete, signal, signage, striping...)
- CenterPoint Energy: adjusting their gas lines
- Xcel Energy: adjusting their power lines
- CenturyLink/Lumen: adjusting their lines
- Minneapolis Park Board (new trees in spring)

Monday - Friday

Work outside of Standard Hours and Days requires a permit in advance.






