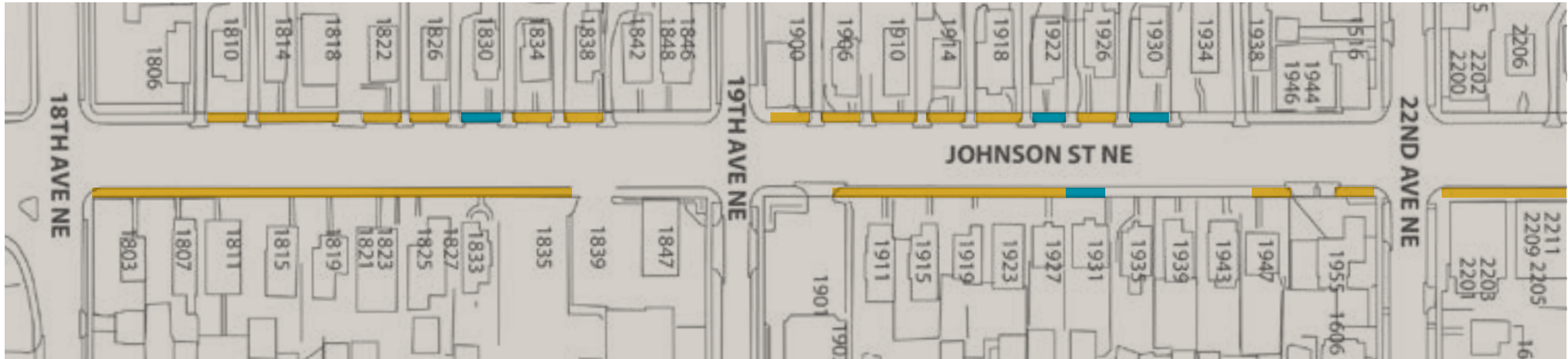


Johnson St NE blvd garden location map
