Welcome to the City of Minneapolis – City Hall Press Workroom. The Press Workroom (Room 382) serves as a designated space for verified journalists to use before, during, and after City Council meetings.

Hours and access to City Hall

Minneapolis City Hall is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on federal holidays or pre-determined closures such as weather emergencies. Members of the media have access to City Hall during business hours, and while observing a City Council meeting extending beyond normal business hours.

Press Workroom

The Legislative Department maintains the Press Workroom on the 3rd floor of Minneapolis City Hall. The Press Workroom is to be used by members of the media for activities in the normal course of covering City Council. Members of the media employed by a newspaper, television, radio, or other news organization are eligible to apply to use the space. Individuals whose applications are granted will be given keycode access to the Press Workroom. The Legislative Department reserves the right to grant, deny, or withdraw access at any time without advance notice. The space will generally be available 30 minutes before City Council meetings, Monday through Friday during regular business hours and 30 minutes after meetings conclude.
